civilians (accurate figures are sketchy). These people came to the assistance of injured and dying individuals after a drone attack. They were performing humanitarian assistance when the drones came back and fired on them. Is that not murder? In accordance with Common Law, murder is the unlawful killing of a human being with malice aforethought. Under most modern statutes in the United States, murder comes in four varieties: (1) intentional murder; (2) a killing that resulted from the intent to do serious bodily injury; (3) a

killing that resulted from a depraved heart or extreme recklessness; and (4) murder committed by an accomplice during the commission of, attempt of, or flight from certain felonies. The killing of civilians is a violation of international law and the UN Charter. In addition, The prohibition of murder of civilians was already recognized in the Lieber Code. Murder of civilians and prisoners of war was included as a war crime in the Charter of the International Military Tribunal at Nuremberg. Common Article 3 of the Geneva **Conventions**

prohibits "violence to life and person, in particular murder of all kinds" of civilians and persons *hors de combat*. All four Geneva **Conventions list** "willful killing" of protected persons as a grave breach. Also, the prohibition of murder is recognized as a fundamental guarantee by Additional Protocols I and II. Murder is also specified as a war crime under the Statute of the International **Criminal Court** with respect to both

international and noninternational armed conflicts and under the Statutes of the International Criminal Tribunals.
